Betting Summary:

Fort Worth is about 250 miles away from Tulsa, while BYU is about 1,200 miles away. Reportedly, ticket sales have not been great for BYU. **Expect home field advantage to favor Tulsa.**

BYU has been playing their best football now, at the end of this season. They enter this game with a head of steam, while Tulsa lost a lot of steam in their crushing loss to Houston at home to finish their regular season.

Last year in Bowl games, teams with the better **average ranking** for combined offensive and defensive **scoring** were 23-12 (65.7%) ATS. Last year in Bowl games, teams with the higher **scoring differential** (difference between offensive and defensive scoring) were 24-11 (~68.6%) ATS. **BYU** is better than **Tulsa** in both categories.

Look for BYU with as many points as possible (from +0.5 up to +2.5), then take them on the money line for the equivalent of 1 unit. If the line moves to BYU +3, then take the field goal and wager 2 units.
